Landed by Parachute 1/2 mile N.W. of Les Cours. Nr St Michel Meuse France.

Picked up by French Helpers immediately Sgt Milburn I53632I my Mid Upper gunner joined me on the first night at 0400 hrs travelled together all the way. Hidden for twentyfour hours given civies and cycles. Then cycled to VERDUN. Stayed in Verdun for 5 days 7th I1th Sept travelled by train to Belfort. Spent night in farmhouse about 7 miles S.E. of Belfort(I1.I2)

Cycled to ^ABEUCOURT stayed in farmhouse for 5 days (I2-I6) Crossed FRONTIER Assisted by the farmer and smugglers. Crossed frontier I6.9.43 Surrendered to Swiss frontier Guards at BURE PORRENTY at 00.I5 hrs I7.9.43.

Porrentry Jail I7-I8 Sept I943.
