H.C., 6 x 90 x 4 lb. and 6 x 8 x 30 lbs. incendiaries, the remainder carrying 1 x 4000 lb. H.C., and 7 x 90 x 4 lbs. and 6 x 8 x 30 lbs. incendiaries. Cameras and nickels were carried. The route taken was :- BASE - 5220N 0140E - 5122N 0320E - 5028N 0632E - TARGET - 5132N 0340E - BASE. The P.F.F. used both the marker flares and ground markers owing to the 10/10ths. low cloud over the target. The defences were up to the usual standard and the searchlights although ineffective, directly tended to light up the cloud as a screen. Night fighters were active.
